JV and Freshman Tournament

Pool Play

1. Pool Play will consist of 2 sets to 25. There is a 27 point cap.
2. The first team listed will be considered the "home" team.
3. The top two teams from each pool will advance to a single elimination tournament.
 1. If there is a tie in pool play, advancement will be determined by:
 - a. 1st: head to head games; the team with the best record will advance.
 - b. 2nd: if the tie still exists; the highest point differential between the games involving just those teams that are tied will determine which team advances.
 - c. 3rd: if the tie still exists; the highest point differential between all games in pool play will determine which team advances.
4. The first place teams from each pool will be placed into the tournament bracket by first place #1, first place #2 and first place #3. First place #1 and First place # 2 will be off for the first round of tournament play, while First place #3 will play in the first round(see tournament bracket)
 1. The seeding for the first place teams will be as follows:
 - a. Overall Pool Play Record
 - b. Points earned from pool play
 - c. Coin flip
