The PSAT is Wednesday, October 11. Registration deadline is Wednesday, September 20. Students who would like to sign up may do so in the school counselor's office. This assessment can be taken by sophomores and juniors. The cost is \$15.

This form, along with documentation from the institution, must be turned into Mrs. Jackson in the Attendance Office the first day back at Central.

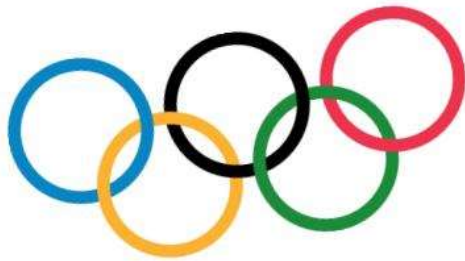
