PSAT

The PSAT is Wednesday, October 11. Registration deadline is Wednesday, September 20. Students who would like to sign up may do so in the school counselor's office. This assessment can be taken by sophomores and juniors. The cost is \$15.

Benefits of taking the PSAT: 1) provides opportunity to enter the National Merit Scholarship Program 2) connection to additional scholarships from leading lenders 3) offers free, focused practice through Khan Academy for the SAT 4) improvement in participation and performance in Advanced Placement courses.

College Visits

We encourage students to visit colleges/technical schools that they are considering attending after high school; starting junior year if they have not already. Students are permitted to take two College Days during their junior and senior year to visit post-secondary institutions. Approval of the visit must be made prior to the day of absence by completing a College Day form in the Counselors Office with their counselor. This form, along with documentation from the institution, must be turned into Mrs. Jackson in the Attendance Office the first day back at Central.

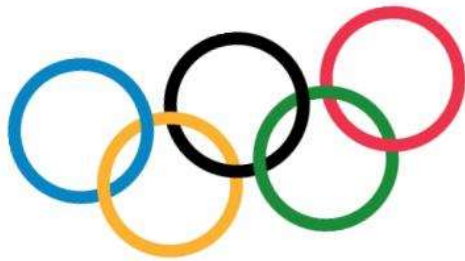
