## **Please Mark Your Calendars for Parent-Teacher Conferences**

Cape Public Schools are trying out a new format for Parent-Teacher Conferences this spring. In the past, each building, Elementary through High School took set their own dates for conferences. This spring, all buildings are hosting Parent-Teacher conferences on the same day. We hope this will allow parents to see all teachers necessary in one day.
