The A+ Program is an effort to enhance educational opportunities for high school graduates. Students who meet the qualification for the A+ Program at Cape Central High School will be eligible to receive incentive funds that apply toward the cost of tuition and general fees at any public community college or vocational/technical school in the state of Missouri for a period of up to two years within forty-eight months after high school graduation. The sooner a student commits to participation in the program (no later than January 1st of his/her senior year), the easier it will be for us to help them fulfill the requirements of the program.
