Government Testing Coming Soon

End of Course (EOC) Testing for all Juniors taking a first semester Government class will take place on November 29. The other half of juniors will test in the spring after they complete their semester of Government. EOC Testing is required by the state and serves as one measure the state of Missouri uses to determine Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP).

EOC's also count for 10% of the student's grade in the course. Additionally, if they score proficient or advanced on the EOC, they are exempt from taking the cumulative final at the end of the semester. If your student will be testing, please help them by making sure that they get a good night's sleep two nights before the test, and a good breakfast that morning.

Students in English II, Biology, Algebra I, and some students in Algebra II will take the End of Course Test for those courses in the spring. More information will be sent home on those tests as we get closer to the date.

Flu Vaccine Clinic

There will be a \$20 charge for students receiving the injectable vaccine unless the student is covered by Medicaid or Medicare. Checks can be made out to "CCHD". The flu mist will not be offered this year as the CDC has recommended against using it for flu prevention.
