**Government End of Course Exams**

Our SEMO Admission Counselor, George Gasser will be here to meet with them in the Counselors Office while they complete the college application. He will review their transcript, senior schedule, and test scores to let them know if they are admissible to SEMO, or what they would need to do in order to be admissible. The \$30 application fee will still be needed; either the day of, or paid at a later time, unless the student qualifies for an application fee waiver (see your counselor).
