Dear Tiger Parents/Guardians,

On April 19, the CHS senior class will be bused to Six Flags in Eureka, MO for a day of fun to celebrate their success over the last four years. Six Flags is only open to high school seniors on this day. Other schools will be at the park, but it is not open to the general public.

In order to qualify for the trip, all seniors must meet the following guidelines:

- No more than five absences between February 7 and April 19
- No disciplinary referrals resulting in ISS or OSS 2<sup>nd</sup> semester
- Passing grades in all classes required for graduation as of April 13

The cost of the trip will be **\$45 per student**, which includes the cost of admission, a picnic meal, and transportation to and from the park. Buses will leave CHS shortly after school starts and will return around 5:30 pm. A bus may be available to bring students back early if enough students need to get back for sports, work, etc.
