## **Summer School**

Summer School enrollment is still underway. Students can use this opportunity for enrichment to get ahead on classes that they may have a difficult time fitting into their schedule during the regular school year or to recover credit from classes they have failed. Summer School runs from May 24 through June 21. Students can sign up for the morning session (7:45 am-10:55 am), afternoon session (11:25 am-2:35 pm), or both.
